Course Overview

This course is an elective for graduate music students who want the opportunity to work on piano skills that would enhance their future career plans.

Actual curriculum for the semester will be determined in consultation with Professor Hilley. Content of both mid-semester and final juries will be taken from the curriculum as determined at a meeting happening no later than the second week of classes. Available times for the consultation are on the calendar posted on Hilley's studio bulletin board (MRH 4.190).

Grading Policy

You will be graded on each applied lesson. This grade is based on your weekly preparation of materials as assigned by your graduate teaching assistant. Your studio grade is 1/3 of your final grade. Professor Hilley and your graduate teaching assistant will grade the mid-semester and final juries. Each of these juries will count as 1/3 of your final grade.

Practice/Attendance
