### **Course Overview**

This course is an elective for music students who have successfully completed the group piano degree requirement.

Actual curriculum for the semester will be determined in consultation with Professor Hilley. ### **Grading Policy**

You will be graded on each applied lesson. This grade is based on your weekly preparation of materials as assigned. Your studio grade is 1/3 of your final grade. Professor Hilley and your graduate assistant will grade your juries. Each jury will count as 1/3 of your final grade.
